Hello Everyone,

Vail Resorts have completed their replacement of chair 11 (Northwoods Express). They indicate the new 6-pack increases up-hill lift capacity by 25%. This is a key link for Apollo Park owners and guests to access Sun Up and Sun Down bowls. All the better to get that early fresh powder skiing in!

Elections saw Gary and Becky Englebright allow their respective terms to expire, with Mark Thompson and Bill Crawford joining Linda Tafoya and Stephanie Urbanowicz on the Board. Thank you all.

The following items were accomplished this past Autumn:

- Our Wi-Fi has been upgraded with a doubling of access points, increased speed, and additional and dedicated equipment installed at Apollo Park. You should see faster and more stable wireless connection throughout the property.
- Our TV service is both upgraded and expanded. Gone is the mix of 57 low-def and high-def channels, replaced by 94 full-HD channels. TV channels include all major college sports networks, HBO and an on-screen program guide.
- Our bedrooms have new comforters.
- Our units now sport all new lovely, comfortable, leather pull-out sofas, new swivel rockers, new ottomans, and fresh throws and accent pillows. The pull-out mattresses are gel-filled and there are no back-breaker-bars to contend with. These are truly comfortable pull-outs.

In 2017 alone, we used our planned Reserves to invest over \$64K on repairs and enhancements to the exterior and over \$100K on interior furnishing replacements. We planned for this, saved for this, and then invested in the property.

We are focused on a quality guest experience, protecting our assets, financial stability, continuous improvement, design standardization, and in-unit timely equal improvements whenever possible.

If you have not been to Apollo Park in the past four years you might be amazed at the substantial investments. We've also created architectural standards, added comfortable pillows, upgraded all linens, upgraded all mattresses, and increased the cleaning.

We've been doing our part: continually upgrading and maintaining the exterior and interior spaces. We truly hope that you enjoy them. New Furniture: We are happy to have been able to purchase new furniture and furnishings during 2017. Please take care of these items just as if they were in your home - charges will be made to the unit occupants if there are damages.

Extra Guests: If you would like to invite more guests than your unit accommodates, contact Anne Nelson. Another unit may be available at a modest price.

Recycling: Apollo Park supports easy recycling. There is a list of recyclable items posted on the refrigerator and a recycle 'blue bin' in every unit. Please ensure that you and your guests participate in the Town of Vail mandatory recycling.

Use Caution - if you are contacted by companies that offer to transfer or sell your timeshare condo so you will never have to pay dues again or if they want to charge an upfront fee to list your condo for sale. Not all companies are trustworthy and if the offer seems too good to be true, it probably is.

Staff: Our Vail staff is available to assist you. Karen and Herman work Monday – Friday and Andrea works Fridays, weekends and after hours. The office number is 970-476-0079, the emergency contact number is 970-390-1190.

To Owners who use two units during the same week: All dishes, furniture, cooking utensils, etc. must be returned to the unit they came from. Please, if you move items from one unit to another, return them before you leave.

Parking: One parking space is available per unit. If needed, call Karen in the Vail office (970-476-0079) to see if any additional spots might be available.

Housekeeping: Housekeepers are on site only on Tuesdays and Fridays of each week. Please remember this when making plans for switching guests or renters.

Fees: Dues payments that are not received by the due date are subject to a \$10 per month late charge and 18% per annum interest charge.

Beginning in 2016 all short-term rental properties renting more than 14 days per year will be required to obtain an annual business license from the town.
