Hello Everyone,

I think back to this past ski season's 197 inches of snow as I write this note. While our snow total was a bit light, we benefitted from Vail's tremendous job of working with what they had to create an enjoyable ski experience. Rental dollars were apparently spent in other areas of the country that experienced more snow. The upside was that more owners enjoyed a stay at Apollo Park instead of renting their units out. It was nice to see you.

Here is how the snow fell by month: November 40% of average, December 52% of average, January 21% below average, February 13% over, March 13% below, and then April at 168% of average. A slow season started on a high note.

For our summer owners, I am happy to tell you that Apollo Park looks great, The buildings are freshly painted, the grounds are beautiful, the flowers are abundant, and the pool has new furniture. It is always nice to be in Vail Colorado.

Apollo Park has recently completed foreclosure action on owners who did not pay their fees. We do this only after attempts to work with owners to bring their accounts current. When they do not take advantage of our offers, we acknowledge there is no alternative but to start the foreclosure process. Now is the time for you to benefit from this.

Prior to releasing the list of re-sales to the open market, we are making foreclosed units available for purchase to current owners, family and friends of Apollo Park. Refer to the enclosed list for units that appeal to you and contact Anne Nelson for purchase details. Do not delay. With all the work on the property recently, we find ourselves in a sales backlog. People want to purchase weeks where we have no availability.

There is no rule change here, but we need to remind owners that your timeshare is allowed ONE parking space. During our peak seasons we cannot accommodate the many requests for extra vehicles and trailers. We have seen increased usage of the property over the past couple of years and have a difficult time handling more than one car per condo. The TOV has conveniently located a parking garage very nearby. Summer day parking is free; there is a fee for overnight parking.

A check-in problem began this past winter for our staff. Renters arrive at Apollo and state they rented through VRBO, but they are unaware of what unit they rented, whom they rented from, etc. We are not even certain if they are actually legitimate renters. Our staff has been forced to spend an inordinate amount of time attempting to guess which owner and unit apply, and making phone calls to verify the rental. They do this all while trying to check in the rush crowd. If you use VRBO, please provide your customers with details. Better yet, let the staff know who will be checking in to your condo. Apollo Park also provides a rental service you can use; contact Anne Nelson for details.

The past few years have seen a series of intense interior and exterior property improvements, now followed by a planned 'breather' from major projects. We hope you enjoy the recent improvements as we work towards more planned and budgeted improvements. Let us know what you think.

**To Owners who use two units during the same week:** All dishes, furniture, cooking utensils, etc. must be returned to the unit they came from. Please, if you move items from one unit to another, return them before you leave.

**Parking:** One parking space is available per unit.

**Use Caution** if you are contacted by companies that offer to transfer or sell your timeshare condo so you will never have to pay dues again or if they want to charge an upfront fee to list your condo for sale. Not all companies are trustworthy and if the offer seems too good to be true, it probably is.

**New Furnishings:** We are happy to have been able to recently purchase new furniture and furnishings.. Please take care of these items just as if they were in your home. New pool towels are now in the condos. Please keep them in your condo as they are not replaced mid-week. If towels are missing at the end of the week, the occupants will be charged.

**Recycling:** Apollo Park supports recycling. There is a list of recyclable items posted on the refrigerator and a recycle 'blue bin' in every unit. Please ensure that you and your guests participate in the Town of Vail mandatory recycling - and be careful to put only recyclables in the bin. Trash must not be mixed in that bin.

**Staff:** Our Vail staff is available to assist you. Karen and Herman work Monday – Friday and Andrea works Fridays, weekends and after hours. The office number is 970-476-0079, the emergency contact number is 970-390-1190.

**Housekeeping:** Housekeepers are on site only on Tuesdays and Fridays of each week. Please remember this when making plans for switching guests or renters.

**Fees:** Dues payments that are not received by the due date are subject to a \$10 per month late charge and 18% per annum interest charge.

**Construction Parking:** It is expected that construction will begin this fall on the Mountain View Phase 2 next door. Staging will be set up in the upper west corner of Apollo Park's parking lot. Most parking for Apollo Park owners and guests will be as usual, but if there is any change, details would be sent to you with your check-in letter.

**DISPLAY YOUR PARKING PASS**

**Town of Vail Parking:** The Town of Vail (TOV) began its summer parking operations in the Vail Village and Lionshead structures on May 25, 2018. The Town of Vail will continue to have **free daytime parking**. New this summer will be a \$25 fee for vehicles stored overnight in the structures. The summer parking fee will extend through September 30, 2018. This is a TOV policy.

**Bustang Service to Vail:** The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) now has linked with Greyhound's national system to provide an **express bus service to Vail**. Bustang is an option for those needing to travel along I-70 and is available from three locations in Denver to the Vail Transportation Center. Single ride tickets are \$17 for adult and \$12.75 for Seniors. Please check on this at <https://ridebustang.com>. ## Short Term Owner Rentals

If you are renting out your Vail property on a short-term basis (30 days or less) the town's Finance Department wants to be sure you are aware that you are required to remit sales tax to the Town of Vail. Beginning in 2016 all short-term rental properties renting more than 14 days per year will be required to obtain an annual business license from the town.

## Are You Recycling Right?

### The Do's and Don'ts of Recycling

The recycling industry is experiencing high levels of contamination - trash in the recycling - at a time when the requirements for quality (clean recycling) are increasing due to new policies implemented by end markets for recyclable materials. Earlier this year, China began to limit the quality and quantity of material it accepts for recycling, impacting the recycling industry world-wide. As a result, our focus on quality is higher than ever, as we work to ensure the long-term sustainability of our recycling programs. When non-recyclable items (contamination) end up in your recycling, they have the potential to turn the entire load into trash, resulting in contamination and additional processing and disposal costs.

#### **IMPORTANT**

Under the service terms Apollo Park has, we may be assessed contamination charges of up to \$69.00 per yard for excess contamination found in the container during recycling collection. Please help us keep our recycling from being contaminated.

#### RECYCLING DO'S

**DO** recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.

**DO** keep foods and liquids out of recycling.

**DO** keep plastic bags out of recycling.

#### RECYCLING DON'TS

**DON'T** bag your recyclables – plastic bags and film get tangled in the machinery.

**DON'T** include food-soiled items - they can turn an entire load of recycling into trash.

**DON'T** add sharp or dangerous materials like needles and electronics – they can cause injury to our workers.

**DON'T** toss in “tangles” like rubber hoses and wires – they can shut down an entire recycling center!

**DON'T** include bulky items like propane tanks or construction debris.
