Hello Everyone,

Apollo Park at Vail remains a busy spot as the Colorado ski season is off to a great start. Lots of early season snow has allowed some of the widest early season terrain openings in recent history. Winter owners will be interested to know that Vail Mountain added snow making capacity on the Born Free trail for 2019 and has increased grooming capacity in the back bowls.

Skiers may wish to download the very useful EpicMix app as it provides real-time mountain and lift status, including your current location, grooming reports and wait times.

Vail Resorts named Boulder-based Eco-Products as its 'Official Zero Waste Partner' as they source sustainable dining products for all Vail Resorts restaurants. Vail is working to eliminate all single-use, guest-facing conventional plastic products, such as cups, straws, beverage lids, plates, bowls and cutlery, and replacing them with compostable or recycled-content products.

The Town of Vail required residents to cut back on water use this past summer as Colorado continues to cope with an on-going, regionally specific, drought. Water usage limits are set for us and fines are imposed if we exceed those limits. Please do your part to help conserve water while in town.

At Apollo Park, new exterior door hardware has been installed to compliment the improved exteriors. The new hardware should also reduce accidental 'I locked myself out' incidents. Various units have new bureaus, new lamps and/or updated accessories. In addition, new linens and kitchen items were purchased in 2018.

Please see the enclosed list of units that are for resale by the Association and owners. You will remember that Apollo Park recently completed a foreclosure action on owners who did not pay their fees. There are bargains included - you can expand your vacation time in Vail.

The 2019 budget has been approved. Interval Owners will see a fee increase of 3.5% while Whole Owners see a slight decrease of .57%. Housekeeping rates are the biggest single item causing the increase.

Thank you to all the owners that attended the annual meeting either in person or by proxy. And thanks to Stephanie, Mark and Bill for agreeing to run for office again, elected by acclamation. Your Board of Directors works well together to maintain and improve your investment.

Our new neighbors at Mountain View 2 have obtained a demolition permit for the landscaping above and adjacent to their parking garage. They continue to pursue building permits for their new project. At this time, there is no effect on Apollo Park.

Real Estate Tax Deduction: Interval owners - 6.8% of your 2018 dues went to real estate taxes; Whole owners - 2.5% of your 2018 dues went to real estate taxes on the land.

Check-in Dates: Please check the 2019 calendar to be certain you have the correct check-in date.

VRBO Renters: If using VRBO or a similar company, please be certain to provide your customer with details of the condo number they have rented and notify the Vail staff about who will be checking in to your timeshare.

Units For Sale or Rent: A list of units for sale or rent is enclosed and can be found in the on-line newsletter. Other units are advertised at www.myresortnetwork.com. Also contact Anne Nelson for options.

Extra Guests: If you would like to invite more guests than your unit accommodates, contact Anne Nelson to see if another unit may be available to rent.

Parking: One parking space is available per unit.

New Furnishings: We are happy to have been able to upgrade furniture and furnishings in the condos. Please take care of these items just as if they were in your home. Pool towels are now in every condo at check-in. Please keep them in your condo as they are not replaced mid-week. If towels are missing at the end of the week, the occupants will be charged.

Housekeeping: Housekeepers are on site only on Tuesdays and Fridays of each week. Please remember this when making plans for switching guests or renters. Also, if you move items from one unit to another, please return them before you leave.

Recycling: Apollo Park supports recycling. There is a list of recyclable items posted on the refrigerator and a 'blue bin' in every unit for recycling items. Please ensure that you and your guests participate in the Town of Vail mandatory recycling - and be careful to put only recyclables in the bin. Trash must not be mixed in that bin.

Fees: Dues payments that are not received by the due date are subject to a \$10 per month late charge and 18% per annum interest charge.

Use Caution if you are contacted by companies that offer to transfer or sell your timeshare condo so you will never have to pay dues again or if they want to charge an upfront fee to list your condo for sale. Not all companies are trustworthy and if the offer seems too good to be true, it probably is.

Construction / Parking: In July 2018 we expected construction to begin in the fall on the Mountain View Phase 2 project next door. Various delays kept that from happening. At this time, we expect Apollo Park owners will find parking as usual even when that project does begin.

Are You Recycling Right?

The recycling industry is experiencing high levels of contamination - trash in the recycling - at a time when the requirements for quality (clean recycling) are increasing due to new policies implemented by end markets for recyclable materials. Earlier this year, China began to limit the quality and quantity of material it accepts for recycling, impacting the recycling industry world-wide. As a result, our focus on quality is higher than ever, as we work to ensure the long-term sustainability of our recycling programs. When non-recyclable items (contamination) end up in your recycling, they have the potential to turn the entire load into trash, resulting in contamination and additional processing and disposal costs.

IMPORTANT

Under the service terms Apollo Park has, we may be assessed contamination charges of up to \$69.00 per yard for excess contamination found in the container during recycling collection. Please help us keep trash out of our recycling.

RECYCLING DO'S

DO recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.

DO keep foods and liquids out of recycling.

DO keep plastic bags out of recycling.

RECYCLING DON'TS

DON'T bag your recyclables – plastic bags/film get tangled in the machinery.

DON'T include food-soiled items - they can turn an entire load of recycling into trash.

DON'T add sharp or dangerous materials like needles and electronics – they can cause injury to our workers.

DON'T toss in “tanglers” like rubber hoses and wires – they can shut down an entire recycling center!

DON'T include bulky items like propane tanks or construction debris.
