President's Message:

Hopefully everyone has been able to make it to Vail this year to enjoy their units and also enjoy something that we have not had for a couple of years - no major construction next door to us. Lunar Vail has completed their construction of Mountain View and as a result there is now a lack of construction noise.

As you may remember that when we had our annual open meeting in October we held a second meeting during which overwhelming approval was given by the owners to have the Board look into buying the land that our buildings sit on. Work has been progressing in getting an MAI appraisal on the land. We have received the appraisal and it is in line with the value that the Board was expecting. At this time we are proceeding with the steps as outlined in our Ground Lease. We expect to have a better idea of how this will come together by this fall.

Some of you may have realized that the Town of Vail now has a wireless network that primarily covers the downtown area. Unfortunately coverage at our buildings was very sporadic. Because of that lack and due to a number of requests from the owners we have had our own wireless network installed that covers both buildings. Instructions for logging in will be found in each unit.

During the spring cleanup week Herman, with some assistance, has refurbished four more kitchens. This is a task that is really needed and will take several years to complete.

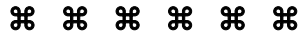
