President's Message:

After crazy and sometimes dangerous weather patterns during May and June, we are back to enjoying our beautiful and more typical summer Colorado weather. Summertime activities were delayed in Vail due to the weather, but now additional on-mountain trails are open and the up-hill bike carry has started. Hopefully you can make it to Vail this summer or fall to enjoy the area and Apollo Park.

After enjoying a great day in Vail, you can sleep well on our comfortable new mattresses! All of B Building and one floor of A Building received new mattresses during the spring cleaning weeks. The remainder of A Building will receive new mattresses during the fall cleaning weeks.

We did a complete walk through and review of all units as well as the grounds and building exteriors earlier this spring. Items needing immediate attention were noted as well as long term goals for upgrades and changes to the condos. The Vail staff gave an extra effort to recover the property from the long winter and to be ready for our owners and guests by Memorial Day.

Since that time, we have seen nearly 100% occupancy by owners and Interval International guests.

Board members are working to establish design standards for the condos at Apollo Park. Everything from paint colors, blinds, furniture, kitchen microwaves to silverware and bathroom fixtures and mirrors to towel bars are being listed. With a master listing, it will be easier to order and replace anything that is worn out or broken – and all owners will know exactly what to expect when they arrive. We recognize that this will take time, but we have begun the process.
